Has held two exhibitions in Cape Town and has been represented at numerous Group Shows, including the Quadrennial Exhibition in 1961.

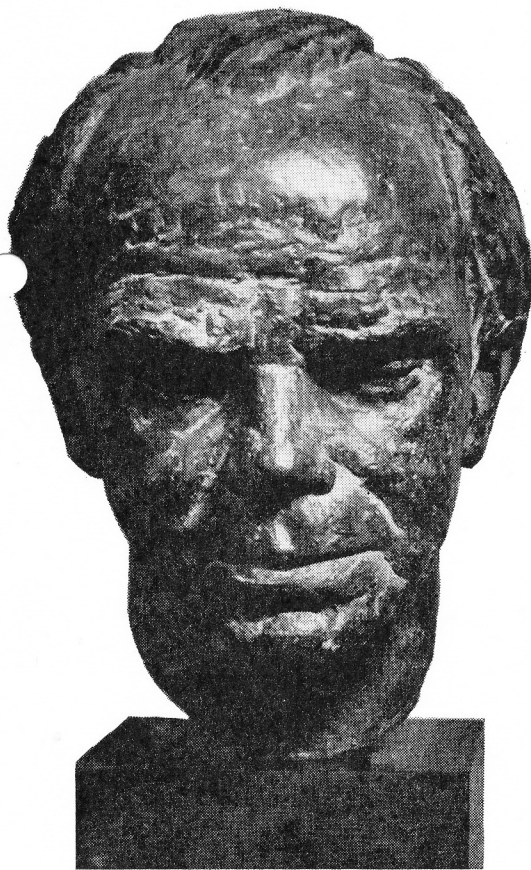
Executed bust of the late Prof. M. van den Ende, Dean of the Medical Faculty, which now stands at the Medical School, Cape Town.
