Gallery and Studio 101, Johannesburg, have a full bill for September. On the fourth, Eric Bird, the Canadian/South African artist, is exhibiting water colours in the Gallery, and on the seventh, the Italian artist, G. Pagi, is showing a collection of oils in the studio before returning to his native land. On September 17 in the Studio there will be a joint exhibition of paintings and graphic work by Zachie Eloff and his wife Renee, of Pretoria. Eloff is a former student of Walter Battiss. And on October 1, the two rooms of the Gallery plus the Studio will be used for an exhibition of copper sculptures by Georg Jaholkowvski of Cape Town. Ten of this sculptor's works were recently bought in the United States.
