



Patrick Wilson, of Irish descent, was born in the Transvaal in 1940. He is a self-taught sculptor and artist who works solely in polyester resin which enables him to handle the complete sculpturing process from beginning to end. Mr. Wilson is to exhibit at this year's Living Arts Exhibition and will hold a one-man exhibition at Gallery 101, Jeppe Street, Johannesburg from October 23 to November 6. Apart from sculpturing, the artist uses polyester resin in graphic-type works, some of which are on view at this exhibition.

He worked as an artist in advertising for 10 years where he held the position of creative director, after which he left advertising and did freelance designing for a year before realising his ambition to be a full-time sculptor at the beginning of this year. His work has appeared in two group exhibitions in Johannesburg, namely '27 South African Sculptors' and 'Leading Pretoria Artists', both sponsored by Gallery 101. He hopes to exhibit overseas in the near future.
