FABIO BARRACLOUGH VALLS

studied painting, Real Academia, Madrid and London; sculpture degree Lanchester University, Britain, 1957;

elected Associate Royal Society of British Sculptors, 1988; served on Council Fellow, 1985;

painted under Dali and Picasso in Spain, surrealist period 1953-63;

produced over 60 large scale sculptures, 1960-74, of which 38 in public parks, buildings in London, Oxford, Cambridge, Birmingham, Southwark, Madrid;

painting exhibitions in four European capitals; began portraits (include Herbert Read, Henry Moore, Barbara Hepworth, C. P. Snow, Sarah Churchill);

Herbert Read wrote: "one of the best draughtsmen in England";

Professor into Universities, 1974-77.
