SOUTH AFRICAN ARTIST RECEIVES THREATENING LETTER.

CYRIL FRADAN, twenty-eight year old South African artist, suffering of Africans under apartheid, said yesterday: "I am afraid for my life". He found a letter waiting for him at the Woodstock Galleries in the West End, where 20 of his canvases are now on show. The letter was addressed to "Communist Fradan", and warned him to stop helping coloured people or face "what the niggers got at Sharpeville". The focal point of Fradan's exhibition is a large abstract representing the agony of the 69 Africans killed in the Sharpeville shootings last year.
