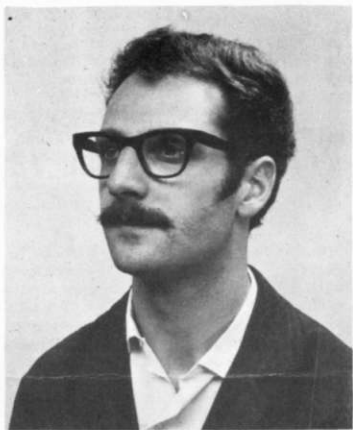


H. Peter Cullman

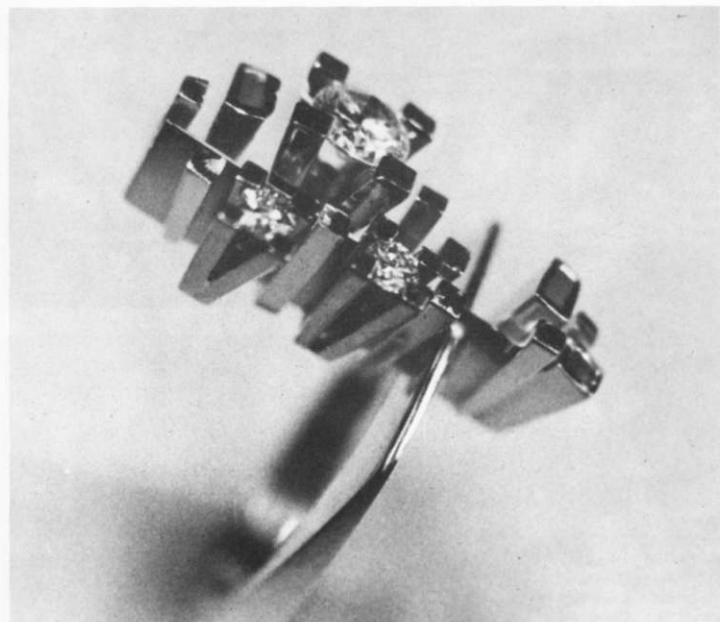
Goldsmith and Designer

H. Peter Cullman is a creative jeweller with an instinctive feeling for his material. His work is contemporary in conception and beautiful in execution. Peter Cullman served his apprenticeship in Idar-Oberstein in Germany. He also attended six art semesters in Pforzheim. He came to South Africa in 1963, after spending some time in Israel, and worked with various jewellers in Johannesburg. He later did a study tour of the United States and Mexico. During the years 1966/7 he went to Canada where he worked in Montreal, for Walter Schlupe the leading Canadian avant-garde jeweller. On his return to South Africa Peter Cullman decided to open his own workshop in Johannesburg. His jewellery is also represented by Gallery 101.

Diamonds unusually set in an elegant 18 carat yellow gold ring.



Very much in the modern tradition, with its abstract design, this beautiful 18 carat yellow gold brooch is set with a shining pink tourmaline and a scattering of diamonds.
