

DUMILE SHOW IN DURBAN

THE young Xhosa artist, Dumile, who has achieved such an extraordinary success on the strength of a few recent one-mans in Johannesburg, has been invited to show in Durban.

The exhibition was arranged during the recent visit to Johannesburg by the Curator of the Durban Municipal Art Gallery, Mme. Z. Wisznicka-Kleczyńska. Shown a collection of Dumile's work at Gallery 101, which has sponsored and encouraged the young unknown, she was so impressed that an exhibition was immediately arranged.

Dumile, a curiously mysterious and elusive figure, has revealed a highly distinctive talent backed by an, at times, disturbing vision.

His exhibition will consist of charcoal drawings, executed on his characteristically large scale, and terra-cotta sculptures. It has been arranged at the Durban Art Gallery for August.
